The MACFT minimum and advertised length of program are the same (10 quarters for students who begin in the Fall quarter or 11 quarters for students who begin in the Summer quarter). For rows in which graduation rates for advertised time and maximum time not equal 100%, students either transferred into another Seattle University School of Theology and Ministry degree program or exited the program. Most students who have left the MACFT program transferred to another degree within the school (e.g., Transformational Leadership). **The MACFT program assures that all requirements are offered so that students may graduate in the advertised time.**
