Seattle University's School of Theology and Ministry (STM) offers annual and endowed scholarships from the great generosity of friends and donors that believe strongly in the mission and vision of the School and the value of an education specifically at Seattle University's School of Theology and Ministry.

Students selected for STM Scholarships are awarded for the remainder of the financial year (summer through spring quarters), based on full-time (6 credits) continuous enrollment. Students enrolled at a half-time (3 credits) status will have their award prorated.
